Bishop Comboni College, founded in 1982, is located in Kambuga Sub-County, Kanungu District, and has 46 teachers and 712 students. Since College has only one small science laboratory, many students taking science lessons have to stand. In addition, the school's existing science laboratory has lack of facilities, not meeting the safety standard of the Ministry of Education. Therefore, this project will construct a new science laboratory block which has four rooms for chemistry, biology, physics and agriculture and procure furniture and science equipment, which will greatly improve students' learning environment.

The Ambassador of Japan to Uganda, H. E. Junzo Fujita, signed the grant contract with Br. John Bosco Kato, Head Teacher of Bishop Comboni College Kambuga, on 24 February 2015 at the Embassy of Japan.
