Ongongoja Secondary School, founded in 2007, is located in Ongongoja Sub-County, Katakwi District, and has 17 teachers and 284 students. Since College has only one small science laboratory, many students taking science lessons have to stand. In addition, the school's existing science laboratory has lack of facilities, not meeting the safety standard of the Ministry of Education. Therefore, this project will construct a new science laboratory block which has three rooms for chemistry, biology and physics, and procure furniture and science equipment, which will greatly improve students' learning environment.

2. Grant Contract Ceremony

The Ambassador of Japan to Uganda, H. E. Junzo Fujita, signed the grant contract with Mr. Akori Michael, Head Teacher of Ongongoja Secondary School, on 9 March 2015 at the Embassy of Japan.
