Ntungamo Health Centre, located in Ntungamo District, Western Uganda has only a maternity ward and a small clinic for outpatients. Other patients than mothers and babies also need to be admitted in the maternity ward when the case is urgent. This exposes the mothers and new born babies to a high risk of being infected. Therefore, this project will construct a general inpatient ward to provide better medical services to 50 patients monthly who need to be admitted to the health centre. In addition, the project will construct a latrine block to provide 24,000 patients who visit the health centre annually with a proper sanitation environment.

2. Grant Contract Ceremony

The Ambassador of Japan to Uganda, H. E. Junzo Fujita, signed the grant contract with Mr. Ocen Ambrose, Town Clerk of Ntungamo Municipal Council, on 9 March 2015 at the Embassy of Japan.
