Kahinju Senior Secondary School was established in 1983 by Diocese of Ruwenzori - Church of Uganda. Currently the school has an enrollment of 1,156 students in total (541 girls and 615 boys) and 45 teachers. 27% of students walk more than 3 kilometers to get to school and girl students in particular are often harassed by men. Most students leave home before dawn and come home in the evening, making them become victims of being attacked by wild animals or violence by strangers. Such long distance commuting makes students exhausted and causes poor performance at school, which leads about 30 girl students to drop out of school every year and the number is continuing to grow. This project will construct a girls' dormitory for 200 girl students in order to reduce the risks of dangerous commuting and provide a better learning and living environment.
