St. Joseph Vocational Training Centre was established in 1989 by Salesians of Don Bosco. Currently the school has 39 teachers and an enrollment of approximately 250 boy students and approximately 180 girl students. The centre offers vocational trainings based on social needs and its graduates receive high evaluation from various industries on their skills. The number of students has been increasing for the past three years and there is an urgent need of supplying daily life water in the dormitory. Since the school has no waterworks facility, the students depend on the existing well and rainwater tanks which are usually inadequate and create a severe water shortage. This project will improve facilities and provide a better learning and living environment for 430 students.
