

Tumboboi Health Centre II is located in Kapchorwa District in Eastern Uganda. The Health Centre was established in 1990 and is the only health facility in Kaptanya Sub County. They provide medical services to about 28,600 people including those from the neighboring district of Bulambuli. Currently they have only one outpatient ward with no admission facility. When patients need to be admitted for further medical care, the health workers have to use limited space on the floor and veranda to treat patients. Furthermore, the number of patients is increasing every year, as well as the number of delivery cases at the facility. Therefore, this project will construct a general inpatient ward and a latrine block, and install furniture, a solar PV system, and a water tank to provide better medical services to patients who need to be admitted to the health centre.
