Odongai Primary School is a government aided school located in Kaberamaido District and was established in 2002. Currently, they have an enrollment of 863 students from P1 to P7. With the number of pupils increasing, the shortage of classrooms has become a serious issue with only 4 classrooms available for all pupils. The most congested class of P1 has 182 pupils in one classroom. Moreover, there is no furniture in the classrooms. Therefore pupils have to sit on the floor when they take classes. Their sanitation situation is not any better. The existing 2 latrine blocks are almost full. Moreover, one stance of latrine is shared by almost 85 pupils contrary to the government standard ratio of 1:40. This project will construct a classroom block and 2 latrine blocks, and install a set of furniture in order to provide better learning environment for at least 863 pupils.
