Lwabiyata Seed Secondary School was established in 2007 and is located in an area adjacent to a landing site for fishermen. The school has a total of 716 students out of which 295 are girls. The school doesn't have proper accommodation. So as to protect and provide a safe environment for girls to study, 90 girls are accommodated in the book store and staff room. Additionally, some students have to walk or ride a bicycle over 15 km to the school every day, and they are in danger of sexual harassment from strangers on the way. Such unfavorable environment for study negatively affects their academic performance and interest in study. The dropout number of girls' students has been increasing every year. Therefore, this project will construct a new girls' dormitory and a latrine and bathroom block, and supply a solar PV system and a set of furniture in order to secure a good learning and living environment for 150 girl students.
