Japan Supports Gulu Core Primary Teachers' College

The Embassy of Japan will commission a newly constructed multipurpose hall at Gulu Core Primary Teachers' College in Gulu District on Wednesday 22nd September 2021. "The Project for the Construction of Multipurpose Hall at Gulu Core Primary Teachers' College" was signed between the Embassy of Japan and Gulu Core Primary Teachers' College on 15th March 2019 with a total grant of USD 134,369 equivalent to over 472 million Ug. Shs.

The Ambassador of Japan to Uganda, H.E. FUKUZAWA Hidemoto, will officiate the commissioning of the project to the beneficiaries.

Gulu Core Primary Teachers' College was established in 1974. At the time of requesting for the grant, the college did not have a hall large enough to properly carry out group lessons, symposiums and exams. As a response to this challenge, the Embassy of Japan supported Gulu Core Primary Teachers' College to construct a multipurpose hall with 350 chairs.

The support is part of the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), a scheme administered by the Embassy of Japan to fund community development projects which uplift the life of people at the grassroots level. So far, a total of 267 projects have been funded under the scheme since its initiation in Uganda in 1992.

Japan, steadily promoting ownership of and partnership with African countries through Tokyo International Conference on African Development (TICAD) process, is committed to assisting the countries' efforts for boosting economic growth, achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and consolidating peace and good governance in Africa.
